

## Hygiene concept of Bike Projects GmbH to avoid infections in the course of the Corona pandemic, during the TrailTrophy in St. Andreasberg on 26/27 June 2021.

The following guidelines must be followed throughout the event. We count on your help to be able to carry out this and other events in this special situation.

### 1. Distance and mask obligation:

- A distance of at least one bicycle length (1.5m) from other persons must be maintained at all times.
- FFP2 masks are mandatory for personal contact and when talking to others. A mask must also be worn permanently on the entire event site and especially while using the lifts. While you are sitting on the bike, it is allowed to take off the mask.
- There is a one-way-rule especially at the start number distribution, but also during waiting times at the event area. A distance of 1.5m must always be maintained.

### 2. Contact Tracking:

- Every guest must register when entering the event area.
- We recommend using the "Luca App". QR codes for scanning are posted.
- Alternatively, written registration is possible on site.

### 3. Parking and Camping:

- Distances must also be observed in the parking lot. Therefore, we must expect reduced parking. On the parking lot the regulations of the operator Alberti-Lift-GmbH apply (are attached).
- Camping: Due to the Corona Protection Ordinance of the State of Lower Saxony, it is not allowed to camp overnight on publicly accessible sites. The compliance with this regulation will be controlled by the public order office and the place will be cleared if necessary.
- Therefore we appeal again urgently to all participants to use the official accommodation possibilities in St. Andreasberg and environment. In addition, the framework conditions of the state of Lower Saxony valid at the time of the event are to be observed and complied with accordingly on their own responsibility.

### 4. Accreditation:

- At the accreditation on 26.07.21 from 9.30 am to 15:00 pm all participants must have a valid 3G certificate. Accordingly, only fully vaccinated, recovered and negatively tested persons will be admitted to the race.
- In the Race-Office there is a one-way-regulation; the check-in & the registration including the control of the 3-Gs will be controlled by trained personnel.

### 5. Testing:

- Approved test methods are PCR testing and PoC antigen testing. - Testing must be performed before the visitor enters the venue and may not be more than 24 hours old.

### 6. Race procedure:

- Only the riders who are immediately before their start will be in the start area. An FFP2 mask must be worn until the rider enters the first transfer. - We must avoid larger crowds. Therefore, the start groups are formed from a maximum of 6 riders. Accordingly, it is all the more important to keep to the specified start times. Those who miss their starting block will start after the actual starting order has been worked through.
- A bike length distance must also be maintained at the start and finish of a stage.

### 7. Sanitary facilities:

- At the sanitary facilities, a notice will announce how many people are allowed to use the area at the same time. As a rule, this is one person. If this is not ensured, the guest must wait in front of the the sanitary area outside until he/she is allowed to use the facility! The sanitary facilities are cleaned several times a day and equipped with paper towels, soap & disinfectants..

### 8. Regulation in suspected cases:

- Suspected cases must be communicated immediately to the organizer during the event.
- The suspected person must isolate him/herself and approach the further procedure in medical care.
- If Covid19 infection becomes known in a visitor or staff member after the event, contact management will be initiated. All visitors will be informed and asked to self-monitor accordingly.

All measures are in accordance with the Lower Saxony Regulation for the Containment of Corona Virus SARS-CoC-2 dated May 30, 2021.
