

## Hygiene concept of Bike Projects GmbH to prevent infections in the course of the Corona pandemic, during the TrailTrophy in Breitenbrunn

The following guidelines must be followed throughout the event. We are counting on your help to make this and other events possible in this special situation.

### 1) Distance and mask requirement:

- A distance of at least one bicycle length (1.5m) from other people must be maintained at all times.
- A maximum of 50 persons including staff may stay in the start and finish area. This is to avoid group formation.
- In personal contact and in conversation with others, masks are compulsory. In addition, a mask must be worn permanently on the entire event area and especially during the use of the lifts. While you are sitting on the bike, it is allowed to take off the mask.

### 2) Parking and camping:

- Distances must also be maintained in the parking spot. Therefore we have to expect reduced parking possibilities. The regulations of the operator Sportpark Rabenberg e.V. apply to the parking spot.
- Camping is possible in principle, but only on the designated area of Sportpark Rabenberg and on payment of a fee. This fee entitles you to use the sanitary facilities. In addition, the rules on distance and group avoidance also apply.
- Furthermore, the general conditions of the state of Saxony valid at the time of the event must be observed and complied with at their own responsibility.

### 3) Accreditation given out/Race Office:

- Both staff and participants are required to wear masks when handing out start numbers.
- When queuing, the distance of 1.5m must be observed. Appropriate markings have been made in advance by the staff.
- To speed up the process, the disclaimers can be filled out and signed by you in advance. These must then only be handed in at the start number distribution.
- If you have the opportunity, you can pick up your start number for a partner. You have to fill in and sign the liability disclaimer and bring it with you, as well as the deposit for the transponder. This can reduce the total number of people at the hand out.

### 4) Race procedure:

- We must try to avoid crowds. Therefore the starting groups will be reduced to 6 people. In the starting block it is also necessary to ensure a distance of 1.5m, which will be controlled by the starting staff. It is all the more

important to keep the given starting times. Whoever misses his starting block starts after the actual starting order has been processed.

- During the transfer routes groups of max. 6 persons are allowed. Large group formation is prohibited.
- Also at the start and finish of a stage a distance of 1,5m between each other has to be kept. This distance will be checked by the Gate Director.
- Whoever is at the finish, please clear the area as soon as possible. Groups are to be avoided here as well.

## 5) Sanitary facilities:

- At the sanitary facilities, a notice will be posted stating how many people may use the area at any one time. Usually this is one person. If this is not guaranteed, the guest must wait outside before the sanitary area until it is possible to use the equipment!

## 6) General:

- Disinfectant dispensers are placed at various central points.
- Your own staff will always wear a mask in the event area when in contact with others.
- Instructions of the event personnel must be followed.
- Spectators are only allowed on the stages and transfer routes. This is to reduce the number of people in the event area..
