

Hygiene concept of Alberti-Lift GmbH to prevent infections in the course of the corona pandemic as well as to stop the spread of the COVID-19 pathogen, valid from 15.05.2020 at the operating sites at Matthias-Schmidt-Berg in St. Andreasberg (chair lift, summer-toboggan run and bikepark)

Measures on site

1. Arrival and parking

- Provision of a sufficiently large parking area, which among other things enables staggered parking for sufficiently large minimum distances between guests.
- parking lot access and exit spatially separated.
- Central signage with rules of conduct at the parking ticket machines.

2. Cash area

- Separating disc between guest and sales personnel.
- Possibility for electronic and contactless payment.
- Keep the (signposted) minimum distance of 1.5 m in the approach area.
- Nose-mouth protection obligation in the approach area if the previous point to the minimum distance cannot be maintained.

3. Waiting zone before the lift (top and bottom terminal)

- Keep the (signposted) minimum distance of 1.5 in the approach area.
- Nose-mouth protection obligation in the approach area if the previous point to the minimum distance cannot be maintained.
- Clear spatial separation of boarding and alighting guests.
- Surfaces of the turnstiles are cleaned regularly (several times a day).

4. Lift transport / use of the chair lift

- Pictograms or sufficient information on transport conditions.
- In chairlift: if same family/household: both seats can be occupied, otherwise only 1 guest per chair.

5. Sanitary facilities

- The **sanitary facilities can only be released for** simultaneous use of **one person** at a time. If this is not guaranteed, the guest has to wait in front of the outdoor sanitary area until he is able to use the facilities!

6. General

- Disinfectant dispensers at various central points.
- Nose-mouth protection obligation, where minimum distances cannot be maintained.
- Creation of "one-way streets" to avoid minimum distances on paths.
- The employees were instructed on the special requirements in dealing with the guests as well as the employees among each other in consideration of the rules of the industrial safety law. Furthermore, the employees were instructed with regard to the consequent compliance with the applicable rules - especially with regard to the special consideration of risk groups as well as the sensitization for the symptoms of COVID-19.
